
Enjoy the Christmas season making extra sawdust for there is no meeting scheduled for December.

Interested in Volunteering?


I have been working with a volunteer organization called CCRT (Catholic Community Response Team) that provides donated furniture and household goods to families in need in the Pontiac area.

They are always in need of small kitchen tables, but since their intake donations are often large dining room tables, they remove the extension leaves and send out the smaller table. I took four sets of the extra leaves, and using boards that I had laying around turned them into four small tables. A nice thing is that the tops can be used with their existing finish, so I didn't have to refinish them. I just stained the rest to match.





They now have eight more sets of leaves, so I am asking if any MWG members would like to build a few tables. I have received quite a bit of donated lumber from old beds, so I believe that with a bit of creativity many tables could be built at no material cost. 


In support of the MWG Toy program, the design staff has been steadfastly at work developing new designs. The latest are a toy pickup truck (F-150) and a dump truck.


